• **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- 1. The Senior Pastor shall provide a pulpit ministry that incorporates the expounding of Scriptures in all doctrine, presentation of a clear message of salvation, and exhorting the church constituency to act upon scriptural teaching in their daily lives. II Timothy 2:2
- 2. The Senior Pastor shall devote time to prayer and personal Bible study in order that he may experience spiritual growth and development in his personal life and ministry.
- 3. The Senior Pastor shall be responsible for administering the ordinances of baptism and communion.
- 4. The Senior Pastor shall be available for personal counseling.
- 5. The Senior Pastor shall be responsible for administering a membership class for prospective members covering the bylaws of the Pandora Missionary Church and the Denomination and any other areas related to the Christian life and the church.
- 6. The Senior Pastor is encouraged to attend conferences and is free to accept leadership roles in the Missionary Church, the District Conference, and other Missionary Church organizations, providing such activities do not hinder his ministry to this congregation.
- 7. The Senior Pastor shall assume the primary teaching role within the church. He shall supervise all associate Pastors and oversee all other teaching roles in the Church.
