Camp team members also received training from a licensed therapist, covering the responsibilities of a camp counselor, mandatory reporting procedures, and how to refer a student who may be experiencing a crisis.

For seven weeks during the summer, camp teams attended twelve different camps and three conferences in Illinois, Indiana, Michigan and Ohio. Camp team members led family groups, became dorm parents, facilitated recreation time, and spent each day alongside the campers throughout the week. Blessed with a solid background in music, for the first time in over 25 years, the GLCC camp team led worship service at four of these camps.

According to VP of Enrollment Greg Stauffer it takes a tremendous attitude to serve as a camp team member. "They serve out of their love for Jesus and students."







From Student to Staff - Following God's Call to Serve

What began as a pursuit in engineering transformed into a passion for people, books, community, and ultimately a new position at GLCC. Jordan Nickels, (B.S., 2025), made the transition from student to staff, being named the Assistant Librarian at GLCC.

Jordan's journey started at Lansing Community College. "After five or so years of college and still occupying a weird space between sophomore and junior year status, I was burnt out, poor, and decided to drop out." During this time, Jordan experienced growth and discovery, which led to opening and running a local coffee shop, a place where many GLCC faculty, staff and students frequented. Jordan learned about opportunities at GLCC, and he fell in love with the GLCC community and its mission. "Once I realized God was moving me onward from the coffee shop, I decided that I simply wanted to help people." In May, Jordan's dream of a college degree came full circle when he graduated with honors from GLCC.

Prior to graduation, Jordan wondered where God would call him to serve. "One day I was catching up with John Nugent, and we organically came to talk about the library." From this conversation, Jordan learned that plans were in motion to expand the library at GLCC, and he could possibly be part of the expansion. "This thrilled me from the start, not only to help run a library, but to stay connected to the amazing GLCC community I had fallen in love with." Jordan prayed about the decision, applied, and was accepted to Wayne State for a master's degree program in library and information science. Showing commitment to his vocation, Jordan was hired as the Assistant Librarian at GLCC.



"It is incredible to be on the other side of things as a member of the faculty and to have the opportunity to help students not only with school work, but with life and everything in between. I feel I'm right where God wants me." Jordan is already developing ways to revitalize the library. "I hope to make the library a space where everyone wants to hang out." Through warm hospitality and a passion for reading, Jordan aims to re-energize the joy of reading in our students.

Bill Warren ('81) is the Executive Director of Fellowship of Associates of Medical Evangelism, whose mission is to send help and hope in the name of Christ to the world's most vulnerable through medical evangelism.
2. **North America: Indianapolis, Indiana**
Matt Cutler ('98) is the Director of Operations at Mission Indy, a non-profit that equips Christians to serve others through experiences in and around Indianapolis.
3. **Central America: Yucatán of Mexico**
Craig ('82) and Rhonda Gates ('81) are the directors of Christ's Mission in the Yucatán, an independent non-profit Christian organization, expanding the Kingdom of God through discipleship.
4. **South America: Melipilla, Chile**

Dr. Edward Rockett



Dr. Ed Rockett joined Great Lakes Christian College in 2023 as an adjunct professor. In June of 2025, he became a full-time faculty member as the Associate Professor of Business Management.

As one who is committed to lifelong learning, Ed followed his formal education by matriculating at Florida A & M University, receiving a B.S. degree in Business Administration and a Master of Business Administration in the Spring of 2003. Immediately following, Ed entered Chicago Theological Seminary where he graduated in May 2006 with a Master of Divinity degree, and in May 2012 with a Master of Sacred Theology. In June 2025, he completed a Doctor of Ministry degree in Christian Community Development from Northern Seminary.

Ed is a second-generation preacher who served several congregations in Florida and the greater Chicagoland area. Currently, he serves as the senior pastor of the Pilgrim Rest Baptist Church in Lansing, MI.

Outside of his clerical and academic vocations, Ed built a successful practice as a financial advisor and sales manager. For over twenty-one years, he worked for several Fortune 500 companies in various roles. Prior to coming to Lansing, he was the President & CEO of his own firm, Rockett Financial Group, where he assisted individuals, families, and businesses in planning for their financial futures. Master of Arts in Practical Theology

After officially being removed from accreditation probation on October 31, 2024, the GLCC team immediately began pursuing the possibility of offering a master's degree in practical theology. This involved a robust feasibility study which determined that a master's program would address the needs of the Great Lakes region and beyond. The faculty team, led by Dr. John Nugent, developed a 36-hour program that will initially be offered completely online via live Zoom classes and can be completed in as little as two years. HLC conducted a site visit to evaluate GLCC's ability to offer such a program. As a result, HLC officially approved the program on April 4, 2025. Time was tight, but GLCC sought to launch the program four months later. Greg Stauffer's enrollment team went right to work, and GLCC's Master of Practical Theology program's first class met this summer with sixteen students enrolled in the program, meeting our projected goal.

To support the new master's program, Dr. Paul Kissling joined the GLCC team as Dean of Graduate Studies, and Dr. Aaron Woods came on board as Graduate Program Coordinator as well as Instructor in Bible for the undergraduate program. Kissling and Woods will be joining Dr. Brian Baldwin, Dr. Esther Hetrick, Dr. Sam Long, Dr. John Nugent, and Dr. Ron Peters who comprise the core teaching team for the program. We are grateful for such a strong start and look forward to a promising future.



MODERNIZING SHARED SPACES




Funded by donations from the Women's Celebration, the cafeteria received a major upgrade last summer. Providing a modern look and feel, the traditional cafeteria was transformed into an updated dining area with two individual restaurants. The first restaurant, "Destinations," serves different items from around the world. "Garden of Eat'n," the second restaurant, serves subs, pizzas, and specialty salads. These, along with a full salad bar and dessert station, give everyone a range of options to eat.





The dining area was upgraded to reflect the colors of GLCC. A four sided mini jumbotron hangs from the ceiling to allow announcements, trivia and events to be displayed. A full beverage center is also available with options for milk, soft drinks, juices, coffee and tea.

Information screens were installed to reduce the amount of random signage and help bring announcements into the modern age. Initially they were installed in the “Information Hall” which displayed all announcements, a calendar of events, and a weather screen. This information is displayed in the cafe and in the front entrance to the building for visitors. The information screens are also capable of displaying safety information in case of an emergency. Additional screens are planned for all dorms, common areas, and the Doty Center.





